

Floor Plan

This compact yet bold two-story home boasts ground floor which is a fluid, open-concept living, dining, and kitchen area where every curve and surface is intentional. Storage space next to/under the staircase contains space for coats, shoes and other every day items.

An L-Shaped staircase arcs gracefully upward, smooth, tactile, and minimal. Upstairs, the bedroom features a panoramic window to the front that offers expansive views, with potential for a skylight overhead that opens like a sleek sunroof, flooding the room with natural light.
